

How to Install Fonts on Windows

1. Download the font file (.OTF or .TTF).
2. Locate the downloaded font file on your computer.
3. Right-click the font file and select ****Install**** or ****Install for all users****.
4. The font will be installed automatically and become available in your applications.
5. If the font does not appear immediately, restart the application you are using.

Alternative Method

1. Open the ****Control Panel****.
2. Go to ****Appearance and Personalization > Fonts****.
3. Drag and drop the font file into the Fonts folder.

How to Install Fonts on Mac

1. Download the font file (.OTF or .TTF).
2. Double-click the font file.
3. A preview window will open in ****Font Book****.
4. Click ****Install Font****.
5. The font will be installed and available in compatible applications.

Alternative Method

1. Open ****Font Book**** from Applications.
2. Click the ****+**** button or select ****File > Add Fonts****.
3. Choose the font file and click ****Open****.
4. The font will be added to your font library.

Note

After installing the font, restart any applications (Canva Desktop, Photoshop, Illustrator, Microsoft Word, Cricut Design Space, etc.) if the font does not appear immediately in the font list.

How to Upload Fonts to Canva

Note: Uploading custom fonts is available with a Canva Pro, Canva Teams, Canva Education, or Canva Nonprofit account.

Step 1: Open Brand Kit

Sign in to Canva.

From the left menu, select Brand (or Brand Kit).

Scroll down to the Fonts section.

Step 2: Upload Your Font

Click Upload a Font.

Select your Magic Alphabet.otf file.

Confirm that you have the right to use the font.

Wait for Canva to upload and process the font.

Step 3: Use the Font

Open any Canva design.

Add a text box.

Click the font dropdown menu.

Search for Magic Alphabet.

Select it and start designing.

Supported Font Formats

OTF (OpenType Font)

TTF (TrueType Font)

WOFF (limited support)

Troubleshooting

If the font does not appear immediately, refresh Canva and reopen your design.

Make sure the font file is not corrupted.

Verify that your Canva plan supports font uploads.

Try uploading the font again if the upload fails.

Short Note for Your Download Page

Using Magic Alphabet in Canva

Open Canva and go to Brand Kit.

Click Upload a Font.

Select the included OTF file.

Confirm the upload.

Your font will be available in the Canva font menu for all future designs.

Custom font uploads require a Canva Pro, Teams, Education, or Nonprofit account.
